

# How to Register for the Nurse Assistant Certification Exam

If you are enrolled in a CNA training program or equivalency program and wish to take the NATAP test upon completing the required hours, please follow the steps below:

1. Complete a nurse assistant certification exam registration application
2. Testing Fees –  
Money order or cashier's check, payable to  
Regional Testing Center

### Testing Fees:

Both Manual and Written Test -----	\$90
Manual Skills Only -----	\$55
Written Test Only -----	\$35
Oral Written Test (additional fee) -----	\$15

**No personal checks or cash will be accepted**

3. Send your completed registration application and testing fees:

- Applications must be received **10 business days prior** to the examination.
- You will be added to the test site roster based upon a complete and accurate application.
- **You may not test if your name is not on the roster.**
- You will be mailed a card confirming your registration.

### *Key Points*

- If you plan to test with your class as a group, your instructor will give you the specific information you need to complete the registration form.
- If you are testing as an individual, or scheduling a retest, please call the regional office (714) 895-8708 and we will assist you in selecting a date and test site.
- If you are an instructor and wish to schedule an exam for your students, please contact the testing coordinator in your area.
- If your equivalency was approved by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), you will be assigned a code number by them. You will be instructed to enter this number as your approval code. Approval date is the date CDPH signed your application.
